1 *The Reformed Security Council,*

2
3 *Cognizant of recent developments in Greece with the overthrow of the elected government by Golden Dawn,*

4
5 *Recognizing the extreme views posed by Golden Dawn,*

6
7 *Recalling Security Council Presidential Statement 2014/23 which condemns the use of terrorism to threaten peace*
8 *and security,*

9
10 *Noting the NATO stance which says that if a NATO member is attacked, it is seen as an attack on the organization*
11 *as a whole,*

13 1. *Demands* an immediate ceasefire in Greece and surrounding Member States to avoid further loss of life;

14
15 2. *Supports* NATO and the EU in their efforts to mobilize troops in the affected areas in order to:

16 a. Fortify NATO bases in the region;

17 b. Protect foreign citizens and other affected members;

18 c. Provide humanitarian aid;

20 3. *Declares its firm opposition* to the tactics used by Golden Dawn to seize power and further their political aims
21 including the use of hostages by Golden Dawn;

22
23 4. *Supports* diplomatic communication between the elected government of Greece and Golden Dawn:

24 a. Conducted in a neutral location;

25 b. Moderated by a neutral third party;

26 c. With the aim of peaceful settlement;

28 5. *Encourages* those Member States surrounding Greece, Turkey, and other effected areas to take in refugees of
29 the conflict, providing appropriate services and supports with the support of the United Nations High
30 Commissionfor Refugees;

32 6. *Decides* to remain seized of the matter.
